

Some plants and seeds are unique because of their size. One kind of palm tree in the Seychelles islands has a huge seed that can weigh more than 60 pounds. Found in California, the tallest tree species is the coast redwood, which can grow over 375 feet high. The leaves of the giant Amazon water lily can grow as large as 8 feet across.
