Problem: high school students drink more soft drinks per day than they drink healthier drinks (milk, juice, water.)

Description of Sample Group:

- Grade 11 & 12 students attending St. James Collegiate
- 50% male, 50% female
- friends of researchers plus students in the cafeteria and library

Ethical Considerations:

- 1. Explain the purpose of the questionnaire and how the results will be used
- 2. Protect confidentiality
- 3. Tell the subject that they can decide to not participate or stop at any time and there will be no negative consequences
